Contacting you, Local walks and Photograph / Video consent

Under the new data protection regulations we have to ask you if you wish to be contacted about events associated with school that will not directly affect your child. For example: PTFA events across the year; opportunities to take part in holiday clubs run by our partners or information about Church events.

We hope that you will give your consent so we can text and email information on these types of events.

We seek parental consent to allow children to leave the site with a member of staff for school organised activities for the current academic year that are within walking distance. This includes events such as school swimming lessons, sporting fixtures within the school day, orchestra rehearsals, and local topic field study lessons. I would be grateful if you would complete the slip below to say you agree to this. Without this consent, your child will not be able to take part in events, which require him or her to leave the school premises.

At St Thomas, we regularly take photographs/videos of pupils. We use these in a range of ways including the school's prospectus, on the school's website, social media and on display boards around school.

We would like your consent to take photos/videos of your child, and use them in the ways described below. Please be aware that this consent will last for the duration of your child's time at the school unless there is a need to alter the consent.

Any photos used in displays are destroyed when the display is removed. School copies of class photos are stored in secure archive.

All digital photos/videos are removed from the school system when your child leaves the school.

It is a parent/guardian/child's right to refuse this permission and school will respect this right.
